Thank you for your recent request to hold an International Affiliate Meeting at the AUA's 2012 Annual Meeting to be held on May 19-24 in Atlanta, Georgia. The AUA Program Committee met recently and I am very pleased to inform you that your request to hold an Egyptian Urological Association program has been approved for AUA's 2012 Annual Meeting.

AUA usually has approximately 100 urologists from Egypt attend its Annual Meeting each year and since this will be the first time that an EUA program would be held, we recommend planning a program for attendance between 100 to 200 attendees. AUA staff can work with you regarding the number of expected attendees for the program to ensure that appropriate space is assigned. Starting on a smaller scale will allow the program to grow in the future. We are currently holding Monday, May 21, 2012 from 1:00 pm to 4:00 pm for the program. AUA will provide a complimentary meeting room and logistical planning and I have enclosed a full description of the benefits and services provided to programs of this size. AUA recommends that EUA seek commercial/industry support to cover costs associated with food and beverage, audio-visual (projector, microphones), etc. in the amount of \$10,000. If your organization does not plan to seek commercial/industry support, please contact Ms. Sharon Broda.

The AUA is very enthusiastic about holding an EUA program during its Annual Meeting and believes that the session will enhance the diversity of scientific offerings to all AUA attendees. I look forward to continuing to strengthen the friendship and collaborations between our organizations.
